LADY TAK came away fast and prompted the pace from the outside while well in hand, cruised up to engage MOLTO VITA approaching the stretch, showed in front of that rival when asked for run, drew clear inside the eighth pole and was ridden out to the wire. MOLTO VITA broke running, quickly showed in front, set the pace under pressure from the winner, proved no match for that one in the stretch but dug in gamely to be clearly best of the others. ZAWZOOH was bumped at the start, raced close up inside, chased the pace and lacked a rally. EBONY BREEZE stumbled at the start, was outrun early, raced inside on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and had no rally. FORTY MOVES raced in hand outside early, put in a three wide run on the turn and faded in the stretch. CLASS ABOVE was bumped at the start, was pinched back after the start, put in a four wide run on the turn and tired in the stretch. FOREST MUSIC raced close up while between rivals and tired in the stretch.
