Footnotes

PEGASUS TOMMY D. was patiently handled while stalking the leader, responded well when set down in the stretch, wore down the leader during the final furlong to prove best. ONZAIN off to an alert start, set the pace on a loosely-contested lead, dug in when the top one made his presence, failed to keep up but continued on with good courage to secure the place. STORM HOPE tracked the leader along the inside, gained gradually during the stretch drive. VERTICAL FLIGHT within striking distance for three-quarters, lacked the necessary stretch response. CAT THREE APPROACH was no factor. HANGINGONTHEFUTURE was never involved. KARAKORUM BOUND raced along the outside, had no rally and was vanned off after the finish. THE CUFF SHOOTER was no threat. FRENCH ACTION saved ground and tired. SPENCERIFIC tired after going six furlongs. UNCLOUDY DAY had a wide trip and gave way. ARABIAN DESERT was outrun.
