DEVIL MAY CARE stumbled at the start, settled in good position for a half, saved ground on the turn, angled three wide at the quarter pole, surged to the front in midstretch, dug in when challenged in deep stretch and prevailed while drifting out near the wire. AWESOME MARIA was under a firm hold between horses for a half mile, steadied and angled in midway on the turn, swung four wide at the quarter pole then closed steadily in the middle of the track but couldn't overtake the winner in the final strides. NONNA MIA sprinted clear on the rail, set a brisk pace along the inside to the top of the stretch, battled inside the winner into midstretch and weakened from her early efforts. WORSHIP THE MOON stalked four wide along the backstretch, raced just outside the leaders to the top of the stretch and lacked a strong closing response. FRANNY FREUD raced in close contention between horses into upper stretch and gradually tired thereafter. TOUCHING BEAUTY pressed the pace in the two path for five furlongs and gave way. ANNIE'S MELODY trailed throughout.
