Footnotes

LITTLE NICK assumed a good forward position leaving the starting gate, gradually ranged up three wide in preparation for the stretch drive, took off in earnest when asked for a response in upper stretch, collared the leader by the eighth pole, then edged away while being kept busy to the end. SUPER CHUNKY off the inside, was urged on the turn to keep pace, angled out several paths in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole and rallied with good energy to grab second. MIKOSHI was hustled from the gate to a forward spot, tracked the front runners from the inside under a good hold, was kept on reserve, stuck briefly in traffic as the field headed for the top of the stretch, remained along the rail, keeping pace with MITIGATION under encouragement while placed just behind that opponent's heels, altered course to the outside coming to the eighth pole and continued on willingly to take the show. MITIGATION showed the way towards the inside, was coaxed along to fend off the pressure coming from GENERAL PERFECT during the opening half, was put to much stronger encouragement after turning for home, battled hard to maintain the lead, yielded midstretch and steadily weakened thereafter. POINTING NORTH (SAF) three wide during most of the running around the turn, fanned five wide into the lane, but had no stretch offering to give. YIELD BOGEY unhurried for nearly a half, was stacked six wide at the head of the stretch, failed to fire after being called upon. GENERAL PERFECT hard used from the starting gate, tired after going a half. LEGAL MOVE four wide at the half mile pole, never reached contention.
