ALL FOR THE TRIP made solid contact with GOSSIP COLUMN leaving the starting gate, tucked along the hedge and sat well reserved down the backstretch, picked up interest upon reaching the turn, was eased outward in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths pole, closed the gap on the embattled pair during the later stages of run around the bend, was already under encouragement spinning four wide into the lane, lost none of his momentum, gaining ground readily during the ensuing furlong, collared the runner up with about a sixteenth to go and edged away. GOSSIP COLUMN broke outward, bumping soundly with the top one, proceeded down the backstretch to assume a forward post, was coaxed along staying within range of the pace duelers, ranged up to challenge them three wide coming to the quarter pole, went by both to reach the eighth pole with a clear advantage, felt the presence of the winner soon afterwards, relinquished in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, but continued on with good determination to garner place honors. PACKERS VALLEY unhurried for nearly the opening half, motored into contention from the two path leaving the backstretch, using her own natural speed to do, was steadied while in tight quarters between rivals coming to the five-sixteenths pole, eventually squeezed through and continued her bid, rallied with good energy en route for the

show, finishing the final seventy yards back under her own power. WINSTON C dueled intensely from the inside, weakened during the final furlong. TEXAS JOSH sparred with WNSTON C placed at a considerable distance outside initially, alternating on the lead, backed away in upper stretch. SCORCHER swerved inward several path leaving the starting gate, sat near the back of the pack, swung six wide into upper stretch, lacked the needed response. SEAWALKER three wide leaving the chute, was no menace. SCATALICIOUS chased the duel from the outside and folded. CHYHYRYN cut the corner into the lane, had no offering to render. CITIZEN WELLS in a step at the start, was pulled off the nearest opponents, underwent a three wide journey, and was done after completing six furlongs. WHY BROADWAY off the inside, tired. ROCKSTAR COWBOY raced from well off the hedge and failed to reach a contending position.
