**Footnotes**

WEE FREUDIAN was kept on reserve stalking the pace dispute, waited briefly for options coming to the quarter pole, found room to alter course in the vicinity of three-sixteenths pole and did so, kicked in with good energy when asked for a response, poked a head in front in deep stretch and dug in bravely to fend off the others to keep it in front. HOOLIGAN'S DELIGHT raced three wide, displayed a good kick down the center of the course, but came up short at the end. BARREL OF LOVE was kept on hold swinging three to four wide into the stretch, tipped outward one additional path after going a few more strides before being released from a firm hold, closed in fast but had to settle for the show. FREUDIAN DILEMMA rode the hedge for the initial hedge, continued to hug the inside en route to grabbing the final major slice of the pot. PETEY CRAMER dueled intensely from the inside with HAYA'S BOY, got overhauled by a slew of closers departing the furlong grounds. KEY VICTORY raced along the outside and lacked the necessary stretch response. HAYA'S BOY moved up to dispute the pace soon after the start, went at it head to head with PETEY CHARMER until upper stretch, then tired. TURN UP THE MUSIC placed four wide at the top of the lane, had no rally. CHECK THE CITES three wide, was set down by the five-sixteenths pole, folded. ALL CLASS saved ground to no avail. GREY FOOSE displayed brief foot. ESS SHAPE sluggish leaving the starting gate, lost contact well before reaching the end of the backstretch, was put to a protective hold and crossed the finish well after the others had done so to earn a minor award.
