DEFIANT broke to the outside, bumping with BOARDWALK BARON, and being the primary cause for subsequent bumping that involved at least three others, contently tracked the pacesetter from the inside along an unobstructed hedge, moved when ready and took over in the vicinity of five-sixteenths pole, continued for a little while before being asked, at the same time adding to the lead, gave a response when put to encouragement, emerging from the furlong grounds, comfortably in the clear, stayed so under active handling. LION KEEN bumped from both sides very shortly after the start, sat forwardly placed in the three path departing the backstretch, held on well to garner the place. CAPTAIN KEON quickly tucked along the inside route, cut the corner into the stretch, got angled outward and scurried into a prominent position the rest of the way through the furlong grounds, flattened out. LOVEISHEARTANDSOUL lunged at the start, thus avoiding becoming part of the bumping incident during the very initial stages, raced in the two path from between rivals on the turn, was put to a drive fanning into the five path by the three-sixteenths pole, rallied mildly to improve position. BOARDWALK BARON bumped from between rivals just after the field was sent off and running, sat reserved within range from between rivals on the turn, was given his cue for the drive home, got guided inward with a furlong to go, came up empty. GRIDIRON GREAT bumped a few strides after the start, chased three wide and had no rally. BROTHER BRENDAN taken hold briefly after leaving the gate, was able to escape making contact with any of the others, departed the half mile pole four wide, was under a drive a furlong later, left the three-sixteenths pole from the six path, failed to menace. COPPER BEECHES bumped a few strides after leaving the gate, showed the way from the two path while pulling with force on the bit, got overhauled by the winner without putting up resistance after the half was completed and retreated. FIFTH GEAR four wide at the top of the turn, was done after a half.
