SWELL strode a bit green early on climbing while taking some kick back into the turn, rode the rail through the turn coming under a ride just past the three-eighths pole, took closer order along the inside nearing the quarter pole, angled out to swing three wide into upper stretch, rallied to confront the embattled pair a furlong out, dug in and seized command inside the final seventy yards to get up late and prevail. POLECAT broke out at the start bumping FREDDIE FREUD before being corrected, dueled from the two path with that foe to his outside, while coaxed along, got let out swinging just off the inside into the stretch headed for command, poked a nose back in front inside the eighth pole shaking away from his main pace rival as he was confronted by the aforementioned one, fought on digging in inside but was caught in the late stages and forced to settle for the place. FREDDIE FREUD bumped at the start by POLECAT breaking outwards, dueled with that foe to his outside from the three path through the turn, took narrow command straightened for home, fought on until headed inside the final furlong and gradually weakened to the wire while clear of the rest for the show. SLEW'S BREW three to four wide in range of the front ridden along from midway on the turn, spun five wide for home, offered no response and weakened late on. FREDDIE G chased the front taking the overland route through the turn, got urged along from the three-eighths, swung six wide into upper stretch and tired. LULU ROCKS chased the duel two to three wide within close aim, got ridden along at the five-sixteenths, tired in the stretch.
