RUN LUCILE argued the pace while in hand, drew clear when asked and remained clear under a confident hand ride. MUSIC WAY argued the pace along the inside and stayed on gamely through the stretch. LARGER THAN LIFE raced close up inside and finished gamely. LA PIQUE DAME was rated along early, raced between rivals, was steadied on the second turn and finished well. FREE SCARLET chased the pace while three wide and weakened in the stretch. RED ZINGER was rated along inside, saved ground and altered course in the stretch. ANJA was pinched back at the start, clipped heels and stumbled then was rated inside, was steadied into the second turn, raced inside into the stretch and finished well. GRACIOUS LADY was rated along early, raced between rivals and had no rally. NOBEL MITTERAND was taken back early, raced inside, came wide for the drive and was caught in traffic in the stretch. SHOOT THE WAD raced wide throughout and tired. WALKER'S GAL raced greenly outside and tired in the stretch. SILK was steadied at the start and tired.
