STRUMMER away in good order, fought a pair of rivals for command while taking the inside route, began to edge clear after being roused approaching the quarter pole, then drew away during the stretch drive while being kept busy. LOST GOING HOME argued the pace three wide, and held well for the place. FEROCIOUS WON was bumped at the start, remained unhurried while positioned in the three path off the speed battle up front, finished willingly to be along for the show. ZIP TO THE CITY attempted to grab the lead while being four abreast turning for home, flattened out. COME ON CHAS stumbled after being bumped twice at the start, saved ground throughout. BOW OUT fought for the lead between rivals until nearing the top of the lane, gave way. INTIMIDATING bumped at the start, moved in unison with ZIP TO THE CITY to engage the battling trio for the lead late on the turn, failed to sustain the five wide move. REMORSE raced along the outside, was steadied soon after entering the turn, tired after going a half.
