VALTRUS stalked three wide for a half, rallied in the two path on the turn, made a run to challenge in midstretch, surged to the front in deep stretch and prevailed late. STORM CALLER pressed along the rail, dropped back midway on the turn, raced in traffic while splitting horses in upper stretch and finished fastest but could not get up. BIG JEROME set the pace into deep stretch and yielded late. PINCKNEY HILL was under a firm hold for five furlongs, raced in traffic between horses on the turn, steadied and altered course outside in upper stretch and rallied belatedly. CLASSIC CAMPAIGN was outrun to the turn then closed late from outside. R J'S BRIGADE raced in hand for a half, steadied on the far turn and failed to threaten thereafter. PICOU lodged a three wide move to threaten on the turn and flattened out. NEW FANDAN (BRZ) saved ground and lacked a rally.
