Footnotes

WALL OF WORRY well placed during the opening half, angled three wide into the lane, took off in earnest after being put to a drive, wore down SUDDEN SILVER to take charge with an eighth to go then held sway, driving. LIZA TOO reserved three wide, swung five wide into the stretch and came home willingly for the place. SUDDEN SILVER patiently stalked the early pacesetter, went by from the three path at the five-sixteenths pole, without need of much encouragement, was set down after turning for home, with the top twosome in close proximity and gearing up for the stretch drive, relinquished nearing the eighth pole and steadily weakened thereafter. SPIRITUAL TUNE angled sharply towards the inside leaving the starting gate, saved ground around the turn, while racing within good striking distance for nearly a half, was taken off the inside entering the stretch, but lacked the needed response. ELENI'S HOPE off the inside, was no threat. LA BELLE GABRIELLE hesitated at the start and was never a threat. REAL MOON underwent a four wide pursuit and folded. ESSEX FERRY took the overland route around the turn and gave way. WISEMAN'S JET set the early pace from the two path, yielded readily once challenged and faded.
