MYSTIC CITY the early leader along the inside, chose to surrender the front nearing the half mile, came out almost immediately into two path, patiently stalked the new leader from there, made her challenge coming to the quarter pole, spurted away under strong handling, then held sway while being kept busy. LAKESIDE CHAPEL outrun for nearly three-quarters, was stacked seven wide at the head of the stretch and came home with good energy down the outside of the course to garner place honors. TRUST FUND KID reserve towards the inside around the turn, rallied well for the show. APRILMAYJUNE stalked the front runners throughout, was called upon turning for home, but failed to match the top one's acceleration of speed. DOWNTOWN HOTTIE unhurried down the backstretch, gradually advanced into the contention, was strung out in the five time upon reaching the three-eighths pole, swung even wider into the lane and held well during the stretch run. CATCHAPENNY K. lagged behind for nearly three-quarters pole, angled off the inside coming to the eighth pole, and displayed good late foot down the outside of the course. CASA DI VINO forwardly placed, was through after completing three-quarters. LATEDAY EDITION broke awkwardly, raced well off the pace while taking the inside route, angled out in preparation for the stretch run and flashed mild interest after entering the lane. NURSE DOLCE within range four wide at the three-eighths pole, flattened out leaving the furlong grounds. GLORY IN

MOTION was no factor. SIMPLE WESTERN was through after going a half. DEAR CONTENDER stopped after turning for home.
