Footnotes

MY CHARMING CLYDE along the rail down the backstretch, was eased into the two path at the seven-sixteenths pole, was coaxed along to keep pace with the front runners during the run around the bend, made his bid nearing the quarter pole, was put to a hard drive, commencing from upper stretch, grabbed the lead just past the sixteenth pole and edged clear. DIXIE NITE OUT was swung over to the inside at the seven-sixteenths pole, taking up the position that had just been abandoned by the MY CHARMING CLYDE, remained within good striking distance, cut the corner commencing a rail rally, was gently angled off the inside coming to the eighth pole, continued onward, altered course for the final sixteenth and finished willingly to win the place photo. KID TORNADO vied for the lead from the two path, shook free approaching the quarter pole, met pressure again leaving the furlong grounds, yielded the lead and weakened into the third slot. CAPTIVATING CAT stumbled at the start, steadily advanced into contention from the outside, angled outward in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, and rallied mildly en route for the last major share. WORTHY WAGER off the inside, was put to a prolonged drive, but lacked the necessary stretch response. BRAZEN KAT was taken hold of after WORTHY WAGER came in a bit at the start, recovered and rushed up to assume a forward position, argued the pace from the three path from the half mile pole to the five-sixteenths pole before backing off.
