BUCKET O' LUCK raced with the pace while under wraps and stayed on gamely to earn the place. FIRST SPEAR set the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. JUDGE BALLAD chased the pace along the inside and had no rally. LUCOUNT raced inside and had no rally. NORMANDY GOLD raced wide and had no response when roused. PORT HENRY chased three wide and tired.
