RANGER JAMES was outrun for six furlongs, made a strong four wide move on the turn, charged to the front in upper stretch and held off the runner-up under steady urging. PERNICE raced well back for seven furlongs, circled five wide and closed steadily to gain the place. IL SENATORE steadied in traffic on the first turn, forced the pace to the turn, lodged a bid between horses to challenge at the quarter pole and weakened late. JACOB'S DREAM saved ground to the turn, angled out and rallied mildly. BOOK set the pace along the rail for a mile and weakened. GOLDWYN raced in midpack between horses and lacked a rally. PLAYFUL MAJESTY was never a factor. URBANO steadied in traffic on the first turn, raced within striking distance between horses to the turn and lacked a late response. POTOMAC MOON pressed the early pace, dropped back after a half then gave way on the turn. ASK OMMADON forced the pace in the two path for six furlongs and faltered.
