WHO'S Z DADDY assumed a forward position, chased the runner up from the two path, lightly hand urged to keep interest, got set down spinning into the stretch, cut the leader's margin in half during the run through the furlong grounds, continued onward drawing on nearly even terms with a sixteenth to go, grabbed away the advantage for good after a few more strides and edged away, kept to the task at hand. ACKERMAN ROAD broke alertly and established control, was guided over towards the inside, cut the pace, proving ratable and with only the eventual winner offering some semblance of pressure, got put to a drive turning for home, had the top one latch on with a furlong to go, gave up the lead about a sixteenth later, was kept going in willing manner to secure second. PATTY AND NOOCHE rode the rail for most of the way down the backstretch, was in the two path by the top of the turn, drafted behind SMARTY BURNS before tipping outward to be three wide at the five-sixteenths pole, commenced the drive home wider still, mustered up a mild response to take the show. FIRST BID three to four wide on the turn, had no rally. SMARTY BURNS gave chase from near the two path for a half before giving way. REACH FOR YIELD took the inside route, was under some encouragement by the half mile pole, arrived at the five-sixteenths marker already under a full drive, made no headway. RED KNOT was driven three wide into the stretch to no avail. KING KONGRATS taken hold after ducking out awkwardly as the field was sent on its way, was instantly five to six lengths behind the penultimate breaker, raced from off the rail, swung four wide into the stretch, trailed throughout.
