Footnotes

UPWARD away without detectable mishap, assumed a forward position, crept up after going halfway around the bend, vied for the lead as the widest of three for a quarter starting from the five-sixteenths marker, poked a head in front with an eighth to go and kicked away. DETERRENT hooked up a duel with STEALTH STEED nearly from the get-go, was pulling on the bit during the opening stages of their tussle, had the winner arrive on the scene leaving the three-eighths pole, fought for the lead from between rivals until the near the three-sixteenths pole, got shaken off by the top one during the final furlong but showed game ness to garner the place. SOUTHERN SAFARI worked out a tuck into the pocket and contently sat there all the way around the turn, was given his cue and got angled outward for the start of the stretch drive, bumped into ANTONE SUAVEY who in turn got knocked into making contact with

CROSS GATE, made up some ground during the remainder of the run through the furlong grounds, then flattened out. YOU TARZAN was given some early motivation to sit forwardly placed, gave chase along the outside, entered the stretch and lacked a solid late response. HALF WILDCAT three wide at the three-eighths pole, made no impact. OUT OF YOUR MIND bumped lightly with COACH A. J., was quickly sent over to the inside, saved ground until the five-sixteenth pole, angled outward seven wide from that station, mustered up a mild response afterwards while never menacing. CROSS GATE was grabbed hold of after breaking slightly to the outside, departed the backstretch four wide, got bumped while spinning one path wider into the stretch and gave way. ANTONE SUAVEY raced mostly three wide on the turn, was bumped from both turns and gently pinched, from pressure originating from SOUTHERN SAFARI, entering the stretch, tired. COACH A. J. lightly bumped at the break, chased from the two path on the turn and had no rally. FORCE MULTIPLIER faltered off a ground-saving journey. STEALTH STEED along the inside, sparred for the lead with the runner up, was forced to cling to a narrow trying to fend off a pair of foes once the winner joined the dispute in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, kept up the battle until upper stretch before retreating.
