PRETTY POSSIBLE dropped far back early, raced inside, enjoyed plenty of room along the rail and rolled home for the score. PAM D'MONIA was outrun early, rallied inside on the turn, came wide into the stretch and was outfinished. LIFE SAVIOR contested the pace from the outside, drew clear into the stretch, was well clear into deep stretch and was caught while drifting out late. MIAMI PRINCESS was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. ITALIAN SAINT had no response when roused. HIGH RATINGS had no rally. PUNCHIN' GAL contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. GENEVIL chased the pace while three wide and tired. GLITTERING RACKET was finished early. FIDGET raced wide and tired.
