Footnotes

KARAKORUM LEGEND moved into contention with a five wide sweep around the turn, took off after the leader after being roused in upper stretch, reached even terms leaving the furlong grounds, then drew off from that point under strong handling. ROUTINE ADDENDUM well spotted along the inside, availed of an opportunity to slip out to three path midway on the turn, began his advancement towards the leaders, took charge after being set down turning for home, was joined by the top one by midstretch, failed to keep pace with that rival but held well to secure the place. HOT PACE took the inside route, was steadied and angled outward approaching the quarter pole to avoid the fallen rider, came home willingly. BENTON DRIVE raced three wide, was forced to steady and swing outward nearing the quarter pole after the incident occurred. POCKET COWBOYS bumped at the start, raced along the outside, was angled to the extreme outside at the top of the lane, rallied mildly to best the rest. THE PLOT THICKENS raced off the inside, was steadied to avoid the fallen rider approaching the quarter pole and failed to threaten thereafter. GRAND MORNING saved ground and was never a factor. UP FOR LOVE well placed outside, checked after the incident occurred, losing all chance. MONEY WELL SPENT tracked the leader from the inside, was steadied nearing the quarter pole, tired. SHIFTY GUY travelling in the three path, was steadied and taken outward nearing the top of the stretch. JACOB'S DREAM underwent a four wide journey and gave way. TRISTE DOBLE Q broke on top, but dropped back soon after the start, had his rider lose his irons shortly after going a quarter, ranged up to the front with the jockey attempting to regain his irons, then had his jockey fall off approaching the quarter pole. There was a Stewards' inquiry focusing on the incident at the quarter pole before the result was declared official.
