EMMA'S POSSE raced three wide around the turn, was kept on a good hold drafting behind DIGGER KARAKORUM into the stretch, challenged from between rivals from upper stretch until just past the furlongs grounds, grabbed a narrow advantage with about a sixteenth to go, and edged away, kept to strong handling to the end. CALLMETONY unhurried for nearly a half, bid four wide heading for the top of the stretch, battled gamely throughout the stretch run but had to settle for the place. MISSILE MOTOR the widest one of all during the run around the bend, swung five in upper stretch, got straightened away and rallied mildly to secure the show. DIGGER KARAKORUM was hustled to secure a forward position, kept pace from the three path off an ongoing pace dispute, challenged for command between opponents as the field heading for home, came out inadvertently leaving the eighth pole, forcing AL'S LARK to check and lose all momentum, weakened steadily in the final sixteenth. AL'S LARK sat reserved in the two path for nearly a half, was taken in hand, briefly jammed between rivals spinning into the lane, got going again and appeared to be moved willingly when impeded a short distance from the eighth pole, was forced to check and failed to regain any real interest. THE ZIPSTER out broke the field but was soon joined by LEAP DAY, was taken over to the inside near the nine-sixteenths pole, sparred with that rival and gave way. EX PAT saved ground until the quarter pole and was outrun. LEAP DAY was hustled to the front from the starting gate, dueled with THE ZIPSTER from the outside for about a half then backed away.
