RECHARGED three wide towards the rear, progressed steadily on the front when arriving at the five-sixteenths, came under urging nearing the quarter pole, swung four wide at that station, collared the embattled pair on the front nearing the eighth pole, edged clear under a drive kept busy to the end. NEW

YAWKER two to three wide in midpack, got let out at the five-sixteenths, offered up a good rally to secure the place honors while unable to threaten the winner. POWER BLAST midpack saving ground, opted to swing four wide in upper stretch as those inside began to weaken placed to a drive, had to briefly wait at the sixteenth marker as LOUIE MONDELLO tired in front, ran on mildly for the show honors. HOOLIGAN'S DELIGHT settled tracking the pace from the one and one, came under urging at the three-eighths, lost some position in the latter portion of the turn, offered up a mild bid upon straightening for home, got out kicked in the late stages while procuring the last major share. LUIGI P three wide towards the rear, was ridden along from the three-eighths pole, swung five wide for home and got out kicked through the lane. LOUIE MONDELLO was in front briefly from the get go before coming under a hard hold to contently track the duel from the three path, got let out at the quarter pole, kept on until the final sixteenth before weakening. PREACHINTOTHEDEVIL hesitated at the start, was outrun early on, came under urging at the midway point on the turn, spun six wide in upper stretch, offered up mild gain while never threatening. ALCOMATCH two to three wide towards the rear, was pushed along midway on the turn, cornered four wide for home and offered no response. MIMITO BOY dueled while two to three wide, took over the front at the three-eighths pole, was set down cutting the corner into the stretch, led to just prior to the eighth pole, when displaced and on the front and gave way. RED JACK dueled along the inside with MIMITO BOY while accompanied in close range by LOUIE MONDELLO and under urging, got displaced on the front at the three-eighths pole and folded. JET SET CAT hard held inside early on, got let out nearing the three-eighths and tired after a half.
