DELHOMME came inward, taking MUDFLATS along for a short ride, went on to establish command shortly afterwards, sat entrenched in the two path, both down the backstretch and around the turn, had the rider release the rating tactics being applied a couple of jumps before arriving at the quarter pole, fended off what turned out to be the only danger throughout the running of the event, crossing the wire, hand urged. LONG RIVER prompted the winner three wide, got asked for a response in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole with the top one following suit after going on a little further, proved no match, yet was clearly second best. MUDFLATS acted greenly during the post parade and prior to being loaded into the starting gate, shied inward responding to outside pressure coming from DELHOMME once the field was sent off and running, got placed to a snug hold on the right rein, but veered in just enough to brush with SUMMER SANDS afterwards, pursued the top twosome a bit more than three wide on the turn, left the three-eighths pole under a full drive, displayed greenness lugging inward during the initial portion of the stretch run, proceeded towards the wire thereafter with head cocked noticeably in the direction of the grandstand apron. SUMMER SANDS made light contact with MUDFLATS a short distance out of the starting gate, took the two path making his way around the turn, doing so after having been to a prolonged drive, tired. RYDILLUC tracked the front runners taking the inside route on the turn, had already felt the whip before going halfway around it, faltered. GENTLEMAN'S HONOR got away slowly, ducking inward a number of paths at the start, was near the inside making his to the half mile pole but well off the rail during the run around the bend, never reached contention.
