DELAWARE TOWNSHIP flashed good speed along the inside, angled out and advanced three wide approaching the stretch, drew clear in upper stretch then held BEVO safe under a drive. BEVO rallied inside on the turn, swung wide for the drive and finished gamely but could not get to the winner. VALIANT HALORY was bumped at the start, and hustled along early, rallied inside nearing the stretch, angled out in upper stretch and finished well. FOREST CAMP contested the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. SHADOW CASTER was bumped at the start, chased the pace while four wide and tired. KELLY KIP chased the pace while between rivals and tired after a half mile. FALKENBURG contested the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch.
