PICK SIX raced with the pace from the outside while in hand, responded when roused and prevailed under a drive. EXTON raced inside and finished gamely to earn the place. MARCH TO VICTORY was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and was going well late outside. OEDIPUS O'NEAL raced inside and had no rally. GOOD PROSPECT set the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. DABBAAS raced outside and lacked a rally. SPANISH HARLEM (IRE) raced inside and was never in contention. DRAGON FI raced between rivals and tired.
