CALLA LILY was rated along inside, advanced inside into the stretch, responded when roused and finished gamely on the rail, just missing. MIRACLE MOMENT quickly opened a clear lead, set the pace while well in hand and gave ground grudgingly in the stretch. MY RACHEL raced in hand outside, rallied three wide on the second turn and was outfinished. FOR ALWAYS broke awkwardly, was outrun early, rallied four wide approaching the stretch and offered a mild run outside. LADY RENAISSANCE raced in hand early, was into into the stretch and had no response when roused. DEAN'S LIST raced close up outside, chased the pace and tired in the stretch.
