Footnotes

BLANK CHECK away well from the starting gate, prompted the leader from the four path while under a firm hold, ranged up when ready to challenge nearing the quarter pole, was floated out into the six path by the CINDER CONE as that pair headed into the stretch, drew alongside that rival, reaching even terms with an eighth to go, then out dueled that stubborn opponent to prove best just prior to the wire, brushing lightly with that one at several junctures between the furlong marker and the finish line. CINDER CONE quickly took the early lead, was rated well off the inside while cutting the pace, was allowed to drift five wide into the stretch, responded positively once called upon, dueled with the top one right down to the end, brushing lightly with that rival before reluctantly yielding. TAR BEACH well placed off the inside, was asked for some run to keep pace at the five-sixteenths pole, gained gradually during the stretch drive en route for the show. DANTASTIC reserved in the two path, was urged on the turn and tired. ALY'S WHEAT took the overland route and gave way. STORM HOPE was through after 6f. ECRU EGRET sluggish after the break, trailed.
