JAZZY MOVES unhurried while racing along the outside, was forced to swing into the seven path at the head of the stretch to steer clear of the mass of rivals spread up ahead, responded positively when given her cue, was only of three only heads apart for the lead with a furlong to go, continued the fight past that point with MORDECAI JONES, shook free in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and edged away under steady encouragement. MORDECAI JONES reserved off the ongoing early pace activity, began to pick up the pace after going a half, fanned six wide into the stretch, took off in earnest after being straightened away, fought with the top one for command, was unable to keep up with a sixteenth to go, but continued on with good courage to be well clear of the rest for place honors. MOONWALK BEAUTY urged along tracking the pace dispute, saved ground until nearing the quarter pole, found room to maneuver outward, swung four wide into the stretch and rallied mildly to take the show. LADY VALIANT bumped after the start, sat reserved towards midpack, angled five wide turning for home and continued on well enough to earn the last major share. COUGAR CRUISE was bumped after the start, swung five wide into the lane, but lacked the necessary stretch response. ALWAYSINMYDREAMS was bumped at the start, raced within striking distance along the outside, was blocked in traffic, from the quarter pole to the three-sixteenths pole, gained clearance in midstretch, but had little left to offer. Z CATS MEOW underwent a three to four wide chase and tired. SARATOGA TIGER leapt at the start, was never a threat. OLIVE EYE duelled from the three path

and folded. SWEET VENOM disputed the pace head to head from the two path before stopping to a walk.
