Footnotes

CELEBRITY SIGHTING well reserved early on bidding time towards the rear, began to be coaxed along nearing the five-sixteenths, swung one additional path out at the head of the lane while splitting rivals and rallied readily edging clear while being kept busy to the end. THOSE LION EYES saved ground tracking the front from midpack around the turn, angled out into the three path at the quarter pole under a drive and rallied willingly, drifted in during the stretch drive under right handed stick work while securing the place. HILLSBORO BAY tracked from four path down the backside, continued three wide around the turn while under a snug hold, came under a ride nearing the quarter pole and offered up a mild bid to secure the show. ABA DABBLER set the pace while in reserve, saved ground throughout, came under a ride at the head of the lane and steadily faded. COFACHIQUI out footed early while under a prolonged drive passed tiring rivals in the stretch. MS. LYDIAN brushed the gate when breaking inward at the start, vied between rivals midway on the turn under a long drive and offered little. LATIN ROCKS chased the pace while five wide around the turn and faltered. BEAUTIFULNIGHTMARE prominent early on while tracking four wide, came under urging just after midway on the turn and backed off.
