GEISHA GAL bobbed slightly appearing to take a bad step over a loose portion of the course soon after the start, swung three wide entering the backstretch, cut into the leader's once substantial lead, along with most of the others, nearing the half mile pole, was eye to eye with SOUTH SHORE a short distance past that station, rallied in unison with the aforementioned opponent to dispute the pace during the run around the far turn, doing so as the widest of a threesome, shook off the other two just before reaching the quarter pole and spun into the stretch nearly a body length to the good, was given her cue and responded positively, scampering away to open up a comfortable advantage by the furlong marker, kept well clear while kept to brisk encouragement to the end. FLOWER MART underwent a three wide journey, sat well reserved for over six furlongs, proved no match for the winner then just held on to the place. CHANNEL THE GREEN took the inside route until the quarter pole, angled out sharply three wide under urging into the stretch, shied outward after being on the receiving end of some left handed stick work during the initial portion of the stretch run, kept a fairly straight course afterwards, displayed good late foot but fell short of second. CONQUESTA tracked the pacesetter from the inside, had no rally. SOUTH SHORE loosely stalked HE LOVES ME MORE during the opening half, had the winner draw directly alongside in the vicinity of the half mile pole, was let out a notch and rapidly closed in on the pacesetter, with the top one in tow one path further to the outside having no difficulty keeping pace, began to fall late back approaching the quarter pole, despite being the most urgently urged of the trio at that juncture, tired steadily once into the stretch. CATNIPPER raced along the outside and was outrun. HE LOVES ME MORE sped off from the competition, held her largest advantage between calls down the backstretch, was no longer on a loose lead but forced to fight to maintain it soon after entering the second turn, doing so as the innermost of three until a few strides before arriving at the quarter pole, retreated thereafter.
