GAMBLIN FEVER strung out three wide on the elbow chute, took the overland route around the full turn while steadily advancing into contention, got set down for the stretch drive, was the outermost of a tightly-grouped quintet arriving at the eighth pole, battled on resolutely with three of them the rest of the wire and outgamed them all for the decision. FASTEST MAGICIAN got bumped lightly a couple of jumps out of the starting gate, sat reserved in the middle of the pack between rivals for a good portion of the opening six furlongs, responded positively when given his cue heading for the top of the stretch, made up ground during the run through the furlong grounds, split rivals at the eighth pole, battled on gamely to earn the place. BARBARO'S REVENGE patiently stalked the leader from the outside for the opening half, was forced to resume that role, but from the three path around the far turn, once PERVIS vacated the pocket, ranged up and issued a challenge coming to the quarter pole, fought his way to the front during the ensuing furlong, barely, but with a small herd having congregated behind in close proximity, the majority of which were in the midst of their rallies, relinquished to a pair of the previously-described rivals,

but held on well nonetheless to earn the show. FOOLISH TIGER three to four wide on the turn, came home willingly en route for the last major check. GOOD PROSPECT rode the rail until the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, mustered up a mild response and never seriously menaced any of the fighting foursome that eventually hit the board. SPECIAL ACTION bumped at the start, was outrun for over three-quarters, was already under encouragement turning for home four wide, went on to outfinish weak and tired ones. RED LEADER three wide until the three-eighths pole, folded. EAST INDIES bumped at the start, scooted away from the others to establish control, set the opening splits from the inside, being rated on an open lead, came under intensified pressure from another pair after travelling halfway around the turn, kept up the fight until deep into the furlong grounds and gave way. PERVIS tracked the pacesetter while sitting a loose pocket down the backstretch, got eased into the two path nearing the end of the backstretch, closed in and vied from between rivals from midway on the far turn until midstretch, tired. DECIPHERING DREAMS bobbed after getting bumped from between opponents at the break, displayed choppy action and had the pilot cast a concerned look underneath him, was put to a protective hold and allowed to gallop out towards the extreme outside, got pulled up and was subsequently vanned off.
