LEROY'S BOY argued for command from the two path, had the runner up replace LOOKLISTENANDLEARN as the primary pursuer shortly after going a half, got called soon afterwards in response to the new challenger, edged away during the stretch drive, kept to strong encouragement to the end. PAPANOPALOUS three wide departing the backstretch, proved no match for the winner once into the stretch, yet was still clearly second best. HAPPY FELLA saved ground, was angled out three wide in upper stretch, held on for the show. EFFICIENT MARKET raced from between rivals for a good portion of the way around the turn, was taken outward several lanes in midstretch in a search for better racing clearance, mustered up a mild response to secure the final major slice of the pot. KID LIGHTNING hesitated at the break, was given a series of right handed shots near the right shoulder as motivation and rushed up along the inside, remained along the rail throughout and flattened out leaving the furlong grounds. LOOKLISTENANDLEARN vied along the inside, fell back after going a half, was swung to the outside for the start of the stretch run, had little left to offer at this stage and tired. RAPID BURN three wide entering the turn, was under encouragement exiting it four wide, tired. NAVY GUARD lumbered along down the backstretch and was always outrun.
