Footnotes

WRITINGONTHEWALL put to a firm hold, quickly established control, was rated along the inside while showing the way on a loosely-contested lead for nearly three-quarters, felt a definite increase in pressure approaching the quarter pole, from the outside and from another rival directly behind, was let out in response to their challenges, rebuffed both in short order and remained comfortably in the clear to the end. DAWLY sat forwardly three wide until the five-sixteenths pole, moved to issue a challenge in earnest as the field headed into the stretch, was quickly turned back, then just held on long enough to salvage second. SCOTUS reserved in the two path, instantly picked up speed when let out a notch in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths marker, was under a drive taking the three path for entrance into the stretch, finished well, but missed out on the place. INTENSIVIST saved ground, launched an abbreviated bid coming to the quarter pole, had it fizzle out shortly afterwards and backed away. COOL UNDER FIRE tipped into the three path leaving the midway point on the bend, was racing under strong handling fanning out six wide travelling through the furlong grounds, made no headway. CINNAMON BEACH taken hold of at the start to avoid contact, was gently pinched, brought up the back of the pack for the initial six furlongs, was angled out six wide in upper stretch, failed to make any impact. HE CAN RUN stalked the winner from the two path, was put to a drive after halfway around the turn, gave way anyway. AWAKE AT T WIRE strung out four wide on the turn, had little left for the stretch drive.
