SAYAAD vied inside with HAPPY MY WAY who initially was well off the inside, had that foe shake away a bit midway on the turn, remained patiently handed to take closer order nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner roused into the stretch taking command narrowly, dug in inching away from that rival through the final furlong, fought on holding well to prevail over a late charging threat. NINE O WONDERFUL two to three wide towards the rear, came under urging three furlongs out, spun three wide for home, angled out a path straightened away, rallied with good late energy surging in the final stages and missed. HAPPY MY WAY away well, vied for command from well off the outside early on, angled to the three path into the turn taking command and shaking briefly away by midway, got roused when confronted again by his main pace rival cornering just off the inside for home, was headed straightened away, battled on through the stretch keeping on well but was outfinished in the final jumps while safe for the show. TRIPSKI just off the inside in mid pack, came under urging three furlongs out, spun four wide for home, offered up late foot for the last major share. HIERRO three to four wide towards the rear, came under coaxing at the three-eighths pole, swung five wide for home, offered up good late energy by mostly tired foes. NIGHT OFFICER saved ground in mid pack, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, cornered just off the inside for home and weakened in the stretch. FOLK SINGER just off the pace in pursuit three to four wide, came under urging three furlongs out, swung three wide for home and offered no response. TROILUS just off the pace chasing from just off the inside, came under encouragement at the three-eighths and tired in the drive.
