SEEING CLEARLY sat patiently perched from the four path, moved up when ready to bid for command coming to the three-eighths pole, took charge by upper stretch and drew off, driving. MESA GIRL contently stalked the pacesetter from the two path, ignored a long-standing, but inviting hole between rivals until turning for home, was not match for top one but finished willingly to grab the place. LOVELY PROMISE quickly established command, did her best trying to back down the pace while being well rated along the inside, felt pressure from the three-eighths pole on, succumbed to it by upper stretch and steadily weakened thereafter. BOBS PINUP GIRL three wide, was rated while prompting the pace until the seven-sixteenths pole, issued a bid for the lead a sixteenth later, kept up the pressure having been now called for more but could not sustain the move after turning for home.
