COOL BLUE RED HOT off the inside and unhurried down the backstretch, was asked to pick up the pace upon reaching the turn, left the three-eighths pole from the three path and already under a drive, spun one path wider into the lane, took over soon afterwards and emerged from the furlong grounds holding a comfortable advantage, saw that once clear lead cut down to size by the runner up in the late stages, but reached the wire in time to preserve the decision. GOLDEN GULCH patiently stalked the pacesetter from the two path until the quarter pole, responded positively when released from a good hold in upper stretch, was challenging for the lead, positioned between foes, when bumped by SENIORS PRIDE in the vicinity of the eighth pole, losing valuable momentum as a result, resettled back into his best stride and came flying home with a late burst of speed that just fell short of nailing the winner. VISCOUNT tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, was asked for some run to keep pace just past the half mile pole, angled three wide into upper stretch and came finish with good, but belated, energy to grab show honors. ELTHEEB four wide departing the backstretch, lacked the necessary stretch response. ELTISH STAR swung five wide into upper stretch, failed to reach a contending position. SENIORS PRIDE out broke a tightly packed group and established control before leaving the chute, was taken over to the rail and showed the way under a good hold from the rider, sailed along on the front without need of being asked for run until the quarter pole, was let out as the closest pursuers geared up for the stretch drive, was already falling back when he came out slightly after being on the receiving end of some left handed stick work near the eighth pole, bumped with the second place finisher and steadily weakened thereafter. EA three wide at the half mile pole, was under encouragement before reaching the end of the bend, tired.
