Footnotes

BOISTEROUS sat well reserved and well placed from off the inside around both bends and down the backstretch likewise, angled outward sharply three wide into upper stretch, responded immediately when given his cue, picked up ground more readily leaving the eighth pole, grabbed the lead in deep stretch and edged away, crossing the finish under a vigorous hand ride. SLEEPLESS KNIGHT assumed a forward position right from the get-go, was rated accompanying the pacesetter from the outside, crept up towards that opponent departing the half mile pole, reaching even terms a furlong down the road, was asked for run just prior to the quarter pole and turned for home the new leader, increased the lead during the ensuing furlong, but with several others in hot pursuit, showed good determination before reluctantly yielding to the top one in the final seventy yards. MR. RYDER rode the rail during the opening stages, was eased into the two path at the half mile pole, began to pick up the pace nearing the end of the far turn, was under a drive spinning into the stretch, split rivals in mid lane to continue his forward progress, forged on ahead, finishing with good energy to secure the show. MATA KERANJANG quickly established control, set the splits, from the inside and with the rider atop with a good hold on the reins, was put to the test by midpoint on the second turn, kept pace with SLEEPLESS KNIGHT until the quarter pole, fell back steadily during the run through the furlong grounds and beyond. BOOTS AHEAD showed some discomfort, tossing his head from side to side from time to time during the opening quarter before rating kindly thereafter, raced from the three path around the second turn, swung one path wider into the stretch, lacked the needed response. FOLLOWMYFOOTSTEPS broke in the air, was forwardly placed while undergoing a three wide journey, failed to fire once called upon. YUMMY WITH BUTTER under a firm hold early, faded off a ground-saving trip.
