Footnotes

MISSILE MOTOR eager leaving the starting gate, was able to rate kindly in short order, assumed a good forward position, took up chase on the leader while placed towards the two path, bided his time during the run around the bend, was still more or less running on his own courage turning for home, kicked in when finally asked for a response, coming to the three-sixteenths pole, fought his way to a clear advantage a sixteenth later, then fended off PORT ROYAL during the final furlong, despite drifting out and ignoring steady stick work on the right shoulder. PORT ROYAL brushed between rivals a few jumps out of the starting gate, raced within range along the outside during the opening half, was called upon turning for home, chose to alter course to the outside coming to the furlong marker, rather than split a pair of foes just up ahead, continued onward with a good kick thereafter to take the place. LITTLE WISE GUY carved the pace along the inside, came under assault after entering the stretch, readily relinquished the lead and weakened. ONE STARRY NITE along the outside, was coaxed on the turn but failed to gain ground appreciably. KILN CREEK placed under a snug hold leaving the starting gate, was dragged towards the back of the pack, took the inside route, picked up speed under encouragement nearing the top of the stretch, angled outward to continue the bid, but flattened out. WADI SUKI reserved in the opening stages, advanced into a good striking position by the quarter pole, from the four path, and with the rider keeping something in reserve all the while, failed to fire after being let loose. WEST COAST FLIER chased three wide, was put to encouragement approaching the five-sixteenths pole, immediately went backwards, was taken hold of and protected during the remainder of the race, then was pulled up quickly after crossing the finish line for the final check.
