Footnotes

NUCLEAR WAYNE away well from the starting gate, was lightly urged into a forward position before placed under a firm hold after achieving the goal, stalked the leader from the outside, was asked to pick up the pace in preparation for the stretch drive, took off in earnest after being set down in upper stretch, gained a clear advantage during the run through the furlong grounds, came out sharply several paths after receiving strong left handed encouragement, just past the eighth pole, came out a bit more in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, again in response to left handed pressure, then held sway the rest of the way, with the stick now tucked away. CALLIDE VALLEY patiently tracked the front runner while riding along the rail, being lightly coaxed along to keep pace, eased outward after reaching the five-sixteenths pole, swung three wide into the stretch, was forced to steady off heels departing the furlong marker, after NUCLEAR WAYNE crossed over, continued onward with good courage, but had to settle for place honors. JOIN IN THE DANCE lightly urged to the front, showed the way from the rail, being pressed by the top one throughout, was put to the test by that opponent nearing the head of the stretch, readily succumbed and steadily weakened thereafter. MAD FOR SMARTY saved ground until the three-sixteenths pole. MY GOLDEN OPINION left the backstretch from the three path, crept up to the front runners during the ensuing quarter mile, but could not sustain the bid after turning for home. I AIN'T NO SAINT raced along the outside and trailed. An objection lodged by the rider of CALLIDE VALLEY against the rider of NUCLEAR WAYNE alleging interference in the stretch was not allowed.
