Footnotes

RIGBY eager for the lead, was taken hold of after establishing command, edged away from the closest competitors after being given some rein midway on the backstretch, worked his way over to the rail by the half mile pole, saw the lead dwindle down during the run around the bend, spurted away a second time after being asked for a response in upper stretch, emerged from the furlong grounds with a sizeable advantage and safely maintained it under good handling. MONTE rode the rail down the backstretch, was guided into the two path upon reaching the half mile pole, was taken out an additional path at the three-eighths pole to circle by a fading rival, displayed good late foot during the stretch drive, cutting into the top one's margin, en route for the place. METROLOGY unhurried for nearly three-quarters, was asked some run nearing the five-sixteenths pole, came three wide into the stretch and had a good finish down the outside of the strip to grab the show award. QUAY LIME GUY chased the pacesetter throughout, continued the pursuit from the four path at the half mile pole, backed off nearing the quarter pole. LOVE AND HAVOC bobbed at the break, took the inside route, angled four wide into the stretch but failed to muster up a solid kick. LION UNDER OATH chased from the outside, was urged on the turn and tired. GOLLY DAY climbed during the opening stages, raced off the inside and folded after going three-quarters.
