Footnotes

SKY BLUE PINK well reserved off the inside for the opening three-quarters, began to pick up interest approaching the quarter pole, spun four wide into stretch and responded positively when given his cue, rolled into contention during the ensuing furlong, lost none of his momentum, struck the front with about a sixteenth remaining and kicked clear, crossing the wire hand roused. MAJESTIC RAFFY tracked the front runners while saving ground, was eased outward in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home three wide and commenced to rally in earnest, appeared poised to wrest away the advantage at the sixteenth pole when beaten to the punch by the winner, continued onward with good energy to come out on top in a spirited tussle with LONELY WHISTLE for place honors. LONELY WHISTLE contently stalked the pacesetter from the two path until the end of the backstretch, ranged up towards the front runner drawing directly alongside by midpoint, went head with head before shaking free in the stretch, emerged with a clear lead with an eighth to go, but with another pair full of run and bearing down hard, offered some resistance for an additional sixteenth, yielded and weakened into the show slot. BISHOP OF NOLA quickly established command, showed the way from the inside with LONELY WHISTLE keeping pace just off the hind quarters to the outside, was put to the test by that opponent just after completing six furlongs, fought well the rest way around the turn and into the upper stretch, backed away and weakened steadily in the final furlong. SOLVENT lacked the necessary stretch response. PIAZZA DI SPAGNA failed to menace. ROCKY WORLD was never in contention. MR. HOOKER darted to the inside shortly after leaving the gate, saved ground thereafter, cut the corner into the lane under encouragement, had no offering to render. STEPHEN'S REVENGE well placed along the outside for six furlongs, tired.
