BAD DEBT chased from afar from off the inside, gained readily on the runaway leader making his way around the turn, surged by a now exhausted foe a few jumps before reaching the eighth pole, and held sway, driving. MONUMENT HILL urged from the two path around the turn, readily cut into the pacesetter's lead, held well enough to secure second. SUNSHINE RAMBLER saved ground, was under a drive cutting the corner into the lane and was along for the show. VEILED PROPHET brushed at the start, angled four wide into upper stretch, got out finished. WAR HOOT three wide around the turn, had no rally. HOCKLEY broke outward, brushed with VEILED PROPHET but was pulled off in time before making more serious contact, raced from off the inside and folded. FEELS ALL RIGHT (IRE) never reached contention. BREAK UP THE GAME faded off a ground-saving journey. POCKET PATCH sped off from the pack, saw his lead dwindle down rapidly making his way around the turn, got overwhelmed just past the three-sixteenths pole and wilted.
