MONARCH'S MAZE, rated along inside, advanced between rivals on the second turn, responded when set down for the drive, split rivals in midstretch and drew clear, driving. KILLER JOE, rated outside, raced wide on both turns and finished gamely from the outside. MONKEY PUZZLE raced with the pace while under stout restraint, was wrestled back on the backstretch, was steadied along inside into the stretch, altered course in midstretch and was going well too late. GATEWOOD quickly showed in front, set the pace, took a clear lead past the eighth pole and faltered in the final furlong. SHOW FALCON raced close up outside under a hard hold, was rank under restraint down the backstretch, raced three wide around both turns and ducked in in the stretch. PRIMEVAL raced close up inside while in hand, saved ground into the stretch, angled out in upper stretch but lacked a solid finishing kick. ANTITRUST, wrapped up early on, came wide for the drive but had no rally. HOH STEAMER (IRE), away awkwardly and rank under restraint in the early stages, tired after an inside trip.
