SAPODILLA contested the pace from the outside, drew clear when roused and remained well clear under a drive. ANGEL IN THE WIND contested the pace along the inside and continued on to earn the place prize. TWO YEAR WARRANTY was outrun early, raced three wide and offered a mild rally outside. WARM FEELINGS raced close up inside, came wide for the drive and lacked a rally. AUNT BERTIE raced greenly and had no rally. FIRST ENCOUNTER tired after a half mile. QUIET JULIA was outrun early, raced inside and had no rally. SEVASMOKE had no response when roused. HONORABLE JEWEL chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. GOOD AND GONE raced wide and tired. SILENT EMBRACE tired after a four wide trip.
