Footnotes

RACELAND set the pace along the inside into upper stretch, dug in leaving the furlong marker and prevailed while drifting out in the late stages. CALLMETONY raced in the middle of the pack, gained four wide at the quarter pole and closed late in the middle of the track but could not get up. FRENCH TRANSITION raced well back in the two path and rallied belatedly between horses. PAPA JERRY pressed the pace from outside, angled in entering the stretch and lacked a late response. DEBATING was pinched at the start, raced well back along the rail and rallied mildly. RAMPANT never reached contention. AKEBONO raced up close between horses and faded in upper stretch. STERLING HEAT no menace. GOLDEN MAN never reached contention.
