Footnotes

HAMMOCK tracked the front runners from the inside while placed under a snug hold, continued to bide his time departing the backstretch, was forced to remain on hold, stuck behind rivals from the five-sixteenths pole to the three-sixteenths pole, found room to alter course outside of the threesome spread across the track just up ahead, was asked for a response once clear, closed in, reached even terms in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, grabbed the lead soon afterwards and edged away, driving. JIMMY VEGAS contently prompted the pacesetter from the outside, was coaxed along from the five-sixteenths pole to keep pace, received much stiffer handling swinging into the lane, poked a head in front approaching the eighth pole, dug in tenaciously to hold on before yielding in the late stages. SIETE MACHOS was bumped at the break, stalked the leader three wide, made a bid for the lead coming to the quarter pole, held well during the stretch drive, but had to settle for show honors. EIRE'S RUN reserved along the outside for nearly six furlongs, came home willingly to take the last major share. STEAL THE SHOT set down coming to the five-sixteenths pole, was outkicked. WRITINGONTHEWALL broke inward, bumping STORMY SUCCESS into SIETE MACHOS as a result, showed the way being rated along the inside and loosely-contested until the quarter pole,

gave way after turning for home. STORMY SUCCESS bumped with WRITINGONTHEWALL at the start, was quickly guided over to the inside, rode the rail until leaving the backstretch, was put to a prolonged drive but failed to reach a contending position. SMART ENUF well out in the track, was always outrun and subsequently eased turning for home.
