BILLY BEAR broke alertly to establish command, carved the pace from the two path, facing only the mildest of pressure from the closest pursuer, and with the rider applying a firm hold, began to shake free approaching the quarter pole, still having never been asked for any kind of response. lengthened away to what proved to be an insurmountable lead, and coasted home, a handy winner. GREELEY'S LEGACY reserved for over a half mile, was put to encouragement, swinging from the four path into the stretch and gained readily on a confidently-handled winner during the final furlong to be second best. BANKING HOLIDAY brushed several times with BIG MOTOR soon after the start, went on to take up a forward position, was urged prompting the pacesetter from the outside, then was outkicked after entering the stretch. CORVO along the inside early, was taken to the outside at the half mile pole, was urged on the turn but made no significant headway on the top one. BALL FOUR a forward factor for three-quarters, gave way. FREGATA was through after completing three-quarters. BIG MOTOR lunged at the break, exchanged a series of brushes with both BANKING HOLIDAY and SAWTOOTH MOUNTAIN, stumbled after apparently clipping the back of the heels of the former, was outrun thereafter. SAWTOOTH MOUNTAIN brushed several times leaving the starting gate, was never a threat. INCREDIBLE SPEED steadied off a rival's heels down the backstretch, and tired. WEB GEM well placed along the inside, steadily tired after going a half, and was eased in distress nearing the finish line.
