MARVELOUS MARGARET set the pace inside well rated while a bit keen early on, got let out a notch at the five-sixteenths, edged clear, was placed to a drive straightening for home drew clear under a drive kept to task. CAUTION SIGN tracked the pace inside settling just in behind, came under encouragement at the quarter pole, proved unable to reel in the top one through the stretch while battling head to head through the final eighth to prevail in the place battle. SHEZA CLASSY LADY stalked the front from the three path, came under coaxing at the three-eighths pole, spun three wide for home fully engaged by the rider, kicked home readily never able to threaten the winner while fighting through the final furlong nose to nose for the place spot, lost the bob for that position while clear of the rest for show honors. KRISSY KAT stumbled badly at the start conceding two to three lengths, settled just off the inside at the rear, came under a drive at the five-sixteenths, bid mildly passing tired rivals in the stretch. BELLE GALLANTEY leapt slightly at the break, settled three wide towards the rear before progressing into contention from the three-eighths pole, swung four wide for home and weakened. MY SPARKY hustled from the gate, chased three to four wide in midpack, came under a drive at the midway point on the turn and weakened. DATTTTS APPEALING saved ground towards the rear to no avail when set down at the five-sixteenths and offering no response. DISCREET LADY settled in midpack taking the overland route through the turn, steadily retreated in the latter portion of the turn, cornered five wide for home and tired.
