Footnotes

JOES BLAZING AARON assumed a forward position shortly after the start, patiently prompted the pacesetter from the outside, issued a challenge in earnest approaching the head of the stretch, edged away from the others during the run through the furlong grounds to arrive at the eighth pole with none latched on, extended the winning margin, kept to brisk urging. RIGHT ONE (FR) saved ground until upper stretch, angled outward and advanced towards the front runners, split rivals through a sizeable opening past the eighth pole, failed to threaten the winner during the final furlong but finished willingly enough to procure the place. KARAKORUM LEGEND between rivals on the turn, unleashed a run after turning for home to reach prominence by mid lane, flattened out. GRAND RAPPORT made light contact with NON STOP at the start, tucked along the rail coming to the end of the backstretch and took the inside route until the five-sixteenths marker, got eased out and was fanned outward, with UNBRIDLED OCEAN imitating the maneuver, only one path directly to the outside, got set down after making it to be four wide by the top of the lane, mustered up a mild response to take the last major check. UNBRIDLED OCEAN unhurried from off the inside, angled five wide from the five-sixteenths pole, was asked for run simultaneously with GRAND RAPPORT, and got outfinished. AWAKINO CAT chased the front runners being two wide on the bend, was forced to be kept on hold, stuck behind opponents leaving the five-sixteenths pole, found room and altered course outward almost an eighth later, failed to fire after securing sufficient racing room. NON STOP got brushed at the break, argued under light urging to maintain a slight advantage while saving ground, came under heavier pressure after going a half and was soon let out in response, yielded nonetheless, then weakened in the final furlong. WICKED TUNE mildly coaxed along tracking the front runners while sitting a loose pocket, angled out at the quarter pole, had no rally. FREUDIAN DILEMMA underwent a three wide pursuit and tired.
