Footnotes

ZIVO settled near the back of the pack in the early going, tucked along the inside route coming to the end of the backstretch but didn't stay there too long, slipping back into the two path a furlong down the road, drafted behind another foe before angling three wide for the commencement of the stretch, was given his cue and responded eagerly, arrived at the end of the furlong grounds as the closest pursuer amongst a tightly-packed grouping, drew even with the runner up with about a sixteenth remaining, took over in short order and edged away, crossing the wire being primarily hand urged. ULTIMATE EMPIRE kept at a considerable distance from off the rail during the initial stages, issued a three wide challenge coming to the quarter pole to take over, got set down, added slightly to the advantage during the ensuing furlong, but with a cluster of rivals in close proximity from all sides bearing down hard, had the winner snatch away the lead a sixteenth later, dug in well thereafter to preserve the place. BAKE SHOP three to four wide on the bend, held on in a willing manner to secure the show. SOUND OF DRUMS raced from off the rail, got set down turning three wide into the lane, altered course a couple of paths in midstretch, mustered up a mild late response while grabbing the last major check. WARRIOR UP rode the rail, cut the corner into the stretch being hand urged, was force to bide time, lacking the best of racing room approaching the eighth pole, gained enough to launch his rally shortly afterwards, did so and flattened out. ITSAGOODTENDOLLARS quickly tucked along the inside, was pulling on the bit for a good portion of the way down the backstretch, was given some rein and issued a successful takeover of the lead nearing the half mile pole, showed the way holding a short advantage, yielded once the runner up issued a challenge as the third fraction was being set and backed away. JADE RUN was sluggish and well off the inside proceeding down the backstretch, was down along the rail for the run around the bend though, was on the march outward by its latest stages, got fanned six wide into upper stretch, had no offering. STREET SWAGG the earliest of leaders, got replaced on the front end by ITSAGOODTENDOLLARS as the half was being completed, continued to argue

for the lead, but from between opponents for the next quarter, gave way.
